[45c] Airmail Letter Rate to Rhodesia - Basic & Double

When the Imperial Airways' route was extended beyond Kenya in January 1932, the airmail rate to the Rhodesias was set at 45c per ½ ounce and stayed the same until the start of the 'all-up' scheme in 1937. The top cover above, paid at the basic rate, looks deceptive as it appears to have been cancelled by SALISBURY marks dated 13 August 32 - but these are redirection marks applied, unusually, to the stamps. The NAIROBI roller mark, dated 4 August, is faint, so perhaps the clerk was preventing any chance of fraud! The lower cover, cancelled at NAIROBI on 6 April 32, is paid at double rate and has reached Bulawayo on the 9th.

## EAST AFRICA: Postal Rates

Airmail services were disrupted in June 1940, when routes over the Mediterranean were closed after Italy's entry to the war. Even after an alternative air route had been established via West Africa during 1941, capacity still fell well short of what was needed. One way of reducing mail loads was to use light-weight paper that was preprinted and folded to form what were called air mail letter cards (AMLC). Until 1944, these were available only to forces personnel and could be used in East Africa from 11 August 1941. A variety of different designs were produced two types of which are shown.



[25c] Wartime Airletter Rate - Forces



The rate payable was 25c and most types had to have stamps affixed - as shown on the example on the left, routed via APO 2 in Nairobi on 25 May 42 and bearing an RAF Type R10 censor mark. Above is a type first issued in October 1942 printed in South Africa in pale blue ink on flimsy pink paper. This example is from a batch pre-printed with a 25c Kenya & Uganda meter mark. This AMLC bears a poor RAF Type R11 censor mark and has been sent on 5 March 43, via APO 83 in Mombasa, by a Pilot Officer in 209 Squadron. This was based, from June 1942, at Kipevu and was equipped with Catalina flying-boats.







By the end of 1943, trans-African routes had become well established - with BOAC operating several direct services each week between Egypt and West Africa. It became possible to reduce the trans-Atlantic airmail rate from East Africa to the USA and, from 15 December 1943, this became 4s 70c per ½ ounce. The above cover, cancelled at NAIROBI on 18 September 44, has been paid at this rate and has been endorsed, "VIA KHARTOUM & LAGOS", as Khartoum was the point intersection for the BOAC Empire ('Horseshoe Route') service and the Trans-African services, and Lagos was where the connection was made with the Pan American Airways' FAM 22 South Atlantic route - on which the letter would have been carried, via Brazil, to Miami.



 KUT to Ethiopia @ 80c airmail rate. Cover cancelled by very faint RUMURUTI marks dated 8 October 1947. This rate applied from 1 June 1947, when reduced from 1s/30. Fine ADDIS ABABA receiver mark applied on 17 October.
