- 1. That every care is taken of books whilst on loan.
- 2. That they are not kept for any period longer than four months.
- 3. Books, when returned by post, are properly packed and correctly addressed.
- 4. That the cost of forwarding books by post and their subsequent return by post is at the expense of the borrower.
- 5. Books may be borrowed on notification and hand-carried to meetings of the Study Circle in London at no expense to the borrower when it is known that the Librarian will be in attendance. Further, books may be returned to the Librarian at meetings where he is in attendance at no expense to the borrower.
- 6. When the Librarian is not in attendance at meetings, books should be returned by post at the borrowers' expense and not retained until a further EASC meeting.
